

Frank Biermann

Dr. Frank Biermann is a professor at the VU University Amsterdam, The Netherlands, where he heads the Environmental Policy Analysis group at the Institute for Environmental Studies.

He is also a visiting professor of earth system governance at Lund University, Sweden. Dr. Biermann specializes in the study of global environmental politics, with emphasis on climate negotiations, UN reform, and global adaptation governance.

He pioneered the concept of “earth system governance” and chairs the Earth System Governance Project, a global trans-disciplinary research network.

His most recent book, *Earth System Governance: World Politics in the Anthropocene*, will be released shortly by MIT Press.

Among other honors, Dr. Biermann has won a Societal Impact Award for his “path-breaking research on global environmental policy.”

He holds a PhD from Freie Universität Berlin, and master’s degrees in both political science and international law.
